Research is required to advance the understanding of issues related to the effect of physical activity on health and disease prevention among people with disabilities.

to identify research priorities required to advance the understanding of issues related to the effect of physical activity on health and disease prevention among people with disabilities

#### What was the outcome?

a ranking list of 7 research topics

# How long did the research prioritization take?

2 days

# Which methods were used to identify research priorities?

meeting

### How were the priorities for research identified exactly?

Step 1: meeting: participants were asked to formulate and discuss the general topic areas. Step 2: review of literature. Step 3: consensus statement drafted

## Which stakeholders took part?

People with disabilities, clinicians, researchers. 18 participants

# How were stakeholders recruited?

No information provided.

#### Were stakeholders actively involved or did they just participate?

Stakeholders were mere participants of the research prioritization process; they were not actively involved in the process.
